No way that the snow could stop the show !... and even if visitor numbers were affected on the first day, the hall was still buzzing with activity and the conference room was full at 300 people by 10h30 on day 1 !

● Visitors

Professionals participating at the event were **up by 20%** to over **3 000*** despite the inclement weather - a clear sign of the upswing in the sector. Equally important was the feedback from the exhibitors confirming the high proportion of new projects that visitors brought with them to the table.

● The Exhibition

Exhibitor numbers at **224** were up slightly compared with the previous edition in Nantes in 2016. Again the international representation was strong at over 30% with 13 countries represented : Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Netherlands, Sweden, Switzerland, UK, USA.

● The Conferences

A rich programme of international conferences attracted high attendance to the conferences from the first moment to the last and across the two days !

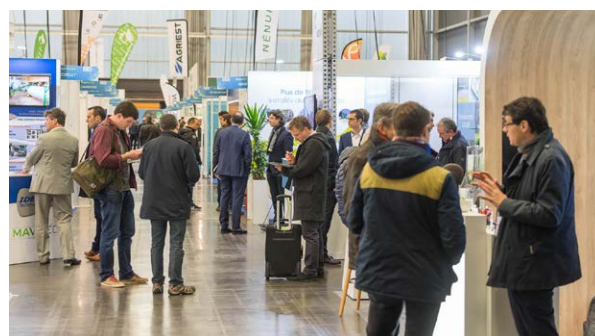
The focus on biomethane on day one was extremely well attended with an average of 250 people in the room at any one time. The pathway to significantly increase the volumes of renewable gas in France by 2030 leading on to 100% renewable gas by 2050 was exhaustively explored.

Day two saw average attendance rates of 225 people through out the day with high participation levels from the agricultural sector and project developers keen to benefit from shared experiences and best practice in approaching a new project. Again, strong attendance levels in the conferences on day two confirm the increased level of new activity in the biogas sector.

Exhibitors benefited from the Forum area to present their innovations and launch their latest releases to the interested participants. Attendance and lively interaction levels enriched the experience for all.



● The International Business Meetings

Excellent attendance of the international business meeting were reported at over 150 meetings - again with a high number of international participants.
